To Whom It May Concern:

This is to certify that all A&E Tape products sold by Pro-Tapes & Specialties complies with the requirements set forth by the European Union Directive 2002/95/EC in regards to the restricted use of certain hazardous substances (ROHS), as follows, in electrical and electronic equipment.

Lead

Cadmium

Mercury (Hg) and – compounds

Hexavalent Chromium (Cr=6)

Polybrominated Biphenyls (PBBs) - flame retardants

Polybrominated Diphenyl Ethers (PBDEs) - flame retardants

Raw materials utilized in the production process may contain unintended impurities that include the aforementioned heavy metals. However, after careful review of raw material specifications, vendor certifications, and random testing, Pro-Tapes has determined that its product does not contain heavy metals as unintended impurities in concentrations exceeding EU regulatory limits. Further, Pro-Tapes does not use any of the aforementioned substances in the production process of A&E products.
